

#### PRODUCT CARE INSTRUCTIONS

You are now a proud owner of a KNF-NEILLE OLSON Mosaic, a work of art with superior engineering. Our tops are cast into our proprietary stone blend that creates a matrix of superior durability. We also incorporate environmentally friendly recycled glass beads to provide a lighter-weight composite for simplified handling and delivery, while at the same time enhancing the quality of the finished product. Our unique molding process provides perfectly smooth tops and sides, ensuring one never has to endure a sharp edge or jagged piece as is found in common, typically-made mosaics. When cared for and maintained properly, this rare combination of elegant beauty and lasting durability will enhance and enrich any environment for years to come.

## **BASIC CARE**

# Sealing

Our tops are treated with a penetrating grout sealer before they arrive to you. We recommend resealing tops with our Mosaic Table Sealer after the first year of ownership and again every five years afterwards. Our special Mosaic Table Sealer can be found through any KNF-NEILLE OLSON dealer. Sealing the top helps to prevent fading, assists in repelling moisture and resists staining. Before sealing, it is important that the top is cool and not exposed to direct sunlight.

- 1. Apply Mosaic Table Sealer liberally to a damp sponge or cloth.
- 2. Using the damp cloth, wipe the entire surface, around the sides and slightly underneath.
- 3. Using a dry cloth, carefully buff the dry tiles. If sealer doesn't immediately clean off the glass tiles, a grout haze remover may be used to ease the process (available at most home improvement centers).

## Cleaning

To clean the tops, use a mild, non-abrasive dish soap and water. A product with ammonia will strip off the sealer potentially causing fading and or cracking.

#### Weather Restrictions

Our tops are suitable for outdoor use. However, we do suggest that they not be exposed to consistent freezing temperatures. Under these conditions we recommend bringing them indoors.

#### Storing & Handling

When handling a top, make sure to lift and lay on a flat surface. <u>NEVER</u> roll it on its side. If storing the top on its side is the only option, ensure there is sufficient padding under the top and in between the surface it will lean up against.
