Cleaning Instructions

Sunbrella® features a soil- and stain-resistant finish that makes cleaning a breeze. Spot wash by sponging briskly with 303 cleaner or a soapy solution of mild soap in lukewarm water. Rinse thoroughly with clean water to remove soap and air dry. You can also clean the cover in your washing machine, however do not use your dryer. After the wash cycle, simply put the damp cover back on the frame on the umbrella and let air dry. After thoroughly dry use 303 Fabric guard.

Solution-dyed acrylic does not promote mildew growth. However, mildew may grow on dirt and other foreign substances that are not removed from the fabric. Simply wash your cover to remove mildew.

Q: Is Sunbrella furniture fabric waterproof?

A: Because Sunbrella fabrics are designed to be breathable, they are water repellent but not completely waterproof. After thoroughly cleaning outdoor materials, you can use 303 fabric guard water repellent recommended by Sunbrella.

Q: Do Sunbrella furniture fabrics provide UV protection?

A: Sunbrella fabrics have been tested and proven to provide up to 98% UV protection from harmful effects of the sun when used in shade applications.
